- 1. Resolution (25R-101) Designating the Emergency Centers for Patient Transport by the Bolingbrook Fire Department
 - Current transport centers are Edward Hospital, Hinsdale Hospital, Adventist Bolingbrook Hospital and Good Samaritan Hospital
 - Removes Hinsdale Hospital, changes the name of Adventist Bolingbrook to UChicago Medicine AdventHealth Bolingbrook
 - Adds Edward Emergency Center in Plainfield, St. Joseph Medical Center in Joliet and Christ Hospital in Oak Lawn
 - Reviewed and approved by Public Safety Committee
- 2. Resolution (25R-102) Authorizing the Purchase of Bulk Rock Salt through the State of Illinois Joint Master Contract with Morton Salt
 - State of Illinois solicited for bids and entered into a Joint Master Contract with Morton Salt
 - Joint Master Contract allows Village to purchase bulk rock salt at \$67.32 per ton
 - Total amount not to exceed 4,800 tons or \$323,136.00, which is \$76,864.00 below the budgeted amount of \$400,000.00.
 - Reviewed and approved by Finance Committee

- 3. Resolution (25R-103) Approving the Proposal of Alliant/Mesirow Financial for Health Insurance Benefits through Blue Cross Blue Shield and Inspira Financial for 2026
 - BCBS will administer medical, dental, vision, life AD&D, voluntary dependent life and ASO STD; Inspira Financial will administer FSA/Dependent Care and Cobra
 - Medical premiums increase by 9.9%; Medical fixed cost is \$2,689,758.00 which is an increase of 24.3%; claims are projected to increase by 9% for a total medical claim liability of \$13,483,286.00
 - Dental premiums decrease by 1.4%; no change in dental fixed costs; total for dental plan is \$482,085.00
 - No change in premium life and AD&D, STD and Dependent Life; costs are \$109,354.00, \$1,018.00, \$7,828.00
 - No change in premium for FSA/Dependent care and COBRA/HIPAA Administration; costs are \$4,284.00 and \$4,310.00
 - Total cost not to exceed \$14,062,964.16, which is under the budgeted amount of \$14,802,738.46
 - Reviewed and approved by Finance Committee
- 4. Resolution (25R-104) Approving the Renewal of Workers' Compensation Insurance Benefits through Illinois Counties Risk Management for 2025-2026
 - Total premium is \$887,789.00, an increase of \$15,676.00 from last year; oversight fee of \$40,000 to Alliant/Mesirow Financial
 - Self-Insured Retention will remain \$400,000.00
 - Total premium cost not to exceed \$927,789.00. This is under the budgeted amount of \$2,937,676.40, of which will cover the SIR of \$400,000.00 per claim and projected claim losses
 - Renews from December 1, 2025, to December 1, 2026
